Activity: BLOOD DONATION CAMP










Day Two: 2-08-2017 (Wednesday)










Day Five: 5-08-2017 (Saturday)















Day Fourteen: 14-08-2017 (Monday)



At the end, student joined hands and took oath to use water properly and not to waste it, to generate healthy eating habits and also took oath to aware and motivate others for doing the same.



GOVERNMENT MIDDLE SCHOOL BURAIL SECTOR 45 CHANDIGARH REPORT ON "POSHAN MAH"



Balanced Diet



Report of Linkage with other schools and Educational agencies to organize Practice Teaching

In the first year the students undergo two pre internship experience in different types of schools while in the second year they have to undertake 16 week internship in different schools

Pre Internship Programme

The pre internship programme is designed for the students of first year to gain early field experiences in observing and assessing students, teachers and classroom behaviour. During this internship they visited different schools in rural locality of Chandigarh. During the internship they observed following aspects of the schools.

- 1. Philosophy, aim and vision of the school.
- 2. Organization & Management (Affiliating body, type of school, type of management)
- 3. The school/classroom environments with reference to infrastructure (area and layout), equipments, curriculum (critical analysis of any class in both teaching subjects), teaching learning materials, utilization of human resources.
- 4. Various co-curricular activities related to dramatics, literary, sports and fine arts etc.
- 5. Morning Assembly (Observation of conduct and activities carried out during morning Assembly).
- 6. After completion of the field exposure programme, student teachers shall be required to develop a detailed report and present it for evaluation at the parent college.
- 7. The teaching learning process in the real classroom, use of multimedia, student participation, classroom management. The student teachers shall observe teaching learning process for which they may use observation schedules. The College develops these schedules; and orient the student teachers on the process of observation as well as use of the schedules.
- 8. Evaluation procedures used in the school a) Types of evaluation
- 9. Library resources
- 10. Types of Grants and Scholarships received by school
- 11. Record of any one stock register
- 12. Visit to innovative centre of pedagogy and learning/educational resource centre.
- 13. Reflections on school experiences (local schools visited)

Similar procedure is followed for pre-internship-2 the school exposure programme is carried out in local/nearby schools located in the urban areas of Chandigarh.

16 weeks internship

16 weeks internship is carried out in the three phases as described below:

Phase-1: Pre-Practice Duration: 2 weeks (In parent institute)

Student teachers learn to write and demonstrate micro, macro, diary,
 ICT, test based and teaching model-based lesson plans.

- Every student teacher goes through one-week simulated teaching practice in each teaching subject.
- Workshop on development of audio-visual aids is organized during thisweek.
- Necessary orientation programmes for Mentor Teachers and Heads of theselected schools are organized by the institute.

Phase-2: Teaching Practice Duration: 14 weeks

The school teaching practice phase is divided into two blocks. In the first block of 7 weeks, student teachers are engaged with students 'of either Upper Primary or Secondary classes; and in the second block of 7 weeks in reverse order. With the permission of higher authorities (DGSE, DEO and school principals) the convenient small groups of student teachers are attached to a school and she undertakes such duties as are assigned to her by the Head Master/Principal of the school in all school related activities. During this period, she has to teach minimum of 60 lessons in each pedagogic subject under the supervision of the mentor teacherand respective teacher educators.

Nomination of Mentor Teachers: During the internship different teachers of the schools are nominated as mentor teachers. The role of the mentor teacher is to share his/her professional experiences, present model lessons, assess student teachers' performance, and provide on-site guidance and support during internship.

Identification of supervisors: The faculty members of the institute are allotted to different schools as supervisors during the internship period. The supervisor coordinates the activities of the mentor teachers of the school; and assess student teachers' performance, and provide on-site guidance and support during internship at least twice a week.

Activities for Student teachers: Student teachers undertake the following activities during this period:

Phase I. Planning and Facilitating Teaching Learning

- (A) Preparing and delivering 120 lesson plans in two teaching subjects (60 + 60)
 - Macro Lesson Plans-40
 - Diary form Lesson Plans- 08
 - ICT Based Lesson Plans- 05
 - Unit Test Based Lesson Plans- 04 (Preparing blue print & conducting unit tests)
 - Lessons Plans based on Models of Teaching 03
- (B) Peer teaching observation 10 +10 in each subject
- (C) Micro lesson plans 5 + 5 in each subject
- (D) Discussion lesson 02 (one in each teaching subject)

Phase II. Assessment of students' performance: Assessment record on the basis of unit tests.

- Participation in organizing co-curricular activities i.e. Literary, Dramatics, Finearts and sports (any two).
- PTA/PTM/SMC

- To incorporate school content with pedagogical subjects of B.Ed. so that students may learn pedagogy practically and it also help them to connect with syllabus of Teacher Eligibility Test (TET)
- To combine 'Language Across Curriculum' and 'Reading and Reflecting on Texts' into one subject as there is overlapping of syllabus
- To enhance syllabus of Communicative English which is Add -On Course in curriculum. At
 present it is less interactive and functional. It has to be made practical by adding
 listening, speaking, reading and writing activities.

- To develop guidelines and curriculum of Teaching Skill Development separately as a manual. It has to be included in first and third semester as per NCTE Curriculum Framework, 2014.
- 7. To add tutorials, field engagements and community service like helping needy children in their studies.
- 8. To add credits of Co-curricular activities/Club activities in DMC-Journal Club, Literary Club, Sports Club, Media Club, Eco Club, Peace and Harmony Club.
- 9. To add credits for National Service Scheme (NSS) in DMC
- 10. To develop curriculum on Choice Based Credit System (CBCS)

Brief outline of workshop

There was brain storming session on B.Ed. Curriculum. After that the faculty of all the three colleges had given their valuable suggestions. There were 16 faculty and all research scholars of Dev Samaj College of Education, Chandigarh, 16 faculty and all research scholars of Govt. College of Education, Chandigarh and 07 faculty and 20 B.Ed. Trainees and of Akal College of Education, Eternal University and 02 research scholars of M.A. (Education), Akal College of Arts and Social Sciences. Altogether 101 participants attended workshop.

A outline of the curriculum was made and faculty were divided into groups as per their specialisation. Each semester were discussed and made in two two days. And in last two days the whole syllabus was winded up. It was a wonderful work done by the faculty of all three colleges.

The curriculum is made as per NCTE norms . The curriculum is made in such a wayso that the B.Ed. Trainees will be develop into reflective practitioners. The course structure offers a comprehensive coverage of themes and rigorous field engagement with the child, school and community. The programme is comprised of three broad inter-related curricular areas – I) Perspectives in Education, II) Curriculum and Pedagogic Studies, and III) Engagement with the Field. All the courses include in-built field-based units of study,tutorials and practicals along with theoretical inputs from an interdisciplinary perspective. Engagement with the Field is the curricular component that is meant to holistically link all the courses across the programme, while it also includes special courses for Enhancing Professional Capacities (EPC) of the student teachers. Transaction of the courses will be made using a variety of approaches, such as, case studies, group presentations, projects, discussions on reflective journals, observations of children, and interactions with the community in multiple socio cultural environments .The workshop ended with vote of thanks.



ACTIVITY: Two Week faculty development program "Transition from Blackboard to Broadband an Online training in Online Teaching"

Date: 27th July 2020 tom 8th August 2020

The pandemic COVID-19 challenged the traditional system of Education. The uncertainties emanating from this contagion were so grave that the governments and the educational organizations and institutions were unable to avoid closure of educational institutions.

In India, all educational institutions were closed since March 24th, 2020 and even examinations were held due to the spread of the contagion. After a few days of closure, many educational institutions initiated a rapid but unplanned move to impart online teaching and learning.

Online teaching was undoubtedly a good step to bridge the void caused by the pandemic in teaching-learning processes and programmes in the country. However, it had its prerequisites to make it effective and successful.

Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC), Dev Samaj College of Education, Chandigarh conducted an online survey during these trying circumstances amid the coronavirus pandemic. It comprised a total sample size of 3550 teachers from different schools. The survey was aimed to study the challenges faced by teachers during online teaching amid COVID-19. It also sought inputs/recommendations from teachers to make online teaching more result-oriented.

The results of the study revealed that 90.2% of teachers were taking online classes for the first time. It was also reported that there was a lack of in-service training in online teaching, which was perceived as a challenge by nearly 60% of the teachers. Some teachers complained

that they were struggling to get a hang of the technology and wanted that they should be given proper training. The study concluded that the use of digital technology in education, a major objective of the National Education Policy that had remained elusive so far, is imperative in these trying times.

In pursuit of these objectives, educational institutions were now required to take a big leap forward in developing and ensuring the digital delivery of education. It was a big challenge, to say the least, but had to be faced with a new normal way of living that the pandemic COVID-19 enforced with innumerable uncertainties and precautions.

The findings of the online survey suggest that majority of the teachers do not have formal training in developing e-content and managing online classes. Majority of the teachers were using social media apps like WhatsApp to deliver the content to the students.

In this background, two key requirements of this new normal mode of delivery education were:

Teacher Training in Online Teaching: The first and foremost requirement of new normal in education is to develop the capacity of teachers in online teacher training. They need to familiarize themselves with the use of technologies adapted in online teaching. Since the pandemic COVID-19 was here to stay for a long time, teacher training, both pre-service and in-service would need to be pursued as a regular faculty development programme.

<u>E-content development</u>: The State Education Departments and institutions need to prepare e-content comprehensively as complete

teaching will henceforth take place either online or in a broadcasting way. The Governments may either provide standard e-content in the local language or allow the local schools to develop e-content, for which they would need to be assisted and trained to develop the capacity. For the training of teachers also, e-content needed to be prepared

Being an institution fully provided with qualified human resources, adequate infrastructure, and technical staff, Dev Samaj College of Education organized a Two Week faculty development program "Transition from Blackboard to Broadband an Online training in Online Teaching" from 27th July 2020 tom 8th August 2020 in collaboration with SCERT, Punjab for teachers working in Government schools of Punjab in Online Teaching to overcome the challenges faced by the teachers in Digital Education and to ensure quality education using digital technology, which, among other things, is imperative to train teachers in Online teaching.

Objectives:

The main Objectives of this FDP were

- Development of e-content by using open resource tools.
- Use of Google educational tools (Gsuite for Education)
 effectively for online teaching. Tools and technologies
 include Google Classroom, Google Drive, Google Calendar,
 Google Forms, etc.
- Development and use of online assessment including preparation of online assessment, quizzes, grading, and evaluation.




ACTIVITY: WORKSHOP ON BASIC LIFE SUPPORT AND CARDIO PULMONARY RESUSCITATION


ACTIVITY: Disable friendly Chandigarh Audit



Dev Samaj College of Education Sector 36-B, Chandiageh examples of differently abled people, who has done wonders in life with good mentorship and guidance.




