
Activity: BLOOD DONATION AWARENESS TALK


ACTIVITY: BREAST CANCER AWARENESS TALK





Partnering Institution: Chandigarh Traffic Police




Activity: Pashu Jagat Celebrations


Activity: Panel Discussion On International Zero Discrimination Day

Then **Mrs. Kanwaldeep Kaur** began the session with a beautiful poetry in Punjabi, highlighting the discrimination faced by married women. She explainedhow Discrimination disregards human rights and hampers the development of the advancing country.

The people of poor and under-developed countries worldwide are of them or edanger of confronting discrimination depending on race, religion, sex and ethnicity. **Mr. Darshan Singh Koonar** was of the opinion that Discrimination of any structure disturbs thefeasible development of the society just as thecountry.

Dr. Namrita Jouhal mentioned many causes of gender discrimination. The first one was Illiteracy. When people do not educate themselves, they continue to live in the old times. Thus, they follow the old-age sexist traditions and norms. Education can bring about a change in this mindset because educated people will less likely partake in gender discrimination. Further, poverty is also another reason which is interlinked in a way. It is the root cause in India because the economic dependence remains on the male counterparts mostly. Thus, women suffer a lot from it because of the same reason. They never get out of this and stay financially dependent on men.

Furthermore, the patriarchal setup in our society plays a big role. In this setup, the male dominates always every aspect of life. Thus, they consider themselves to be superior to others. This way, a lot of violence and injustice is meted out against females. Thus, when there is a gender considering themselves to be superior, it becomes difficult for everyone to avail equal opportunities.

Dr. Namrita then discussed the various impacts of Gender Discrimination. It does not just impact a specific section of the society but every part of it. First of all, it impacts children as they fall prey to gender stereotypes from a young age. Further, it impacts young people because it impacts their behaviour, study choices, ambitions, attitudes and more. Thus many girls do not participate in many sports and women experience physical violence more than men.

It also impacts the aboriginal women because they have it a lot worse. It is more likely to happen that they can die from family violence, 11 times more than men. Even for men, it is not beneficial as it sets difficult standards for men to follow.

It draws a line on men being emotional, thus, they can never showcase their emotions truly without being judged. Similarly, men do not take or given parental leave in many places.

Ultimately, all this results in more suicide in men. Thus, it impacts everyone.

Mrs. Kanwaljeet Kaur further extended the discussion by giving various evidences faced by women in Indian society. For instance she provided the reports of various government surveys that highlights the inequality or the society. The session concluded with the sharing of personal ideas by the students.


. First day of the workshop had four sessions in total.

DAY 2 started with an energetic and enthusiastic lecture by Dr. Neeru Malik on the topic FINANCING OF HIGHER EDUCATION :ISSUES AND TRENDS. The session was started at 10:00 am and lasted till 11:30 am. During the session Dr. Neeru made us understand about the issues faced by the higher institution in terms of procuring finances. She started her lecture with the type of funding agencies like UGC, ICAR, ICMR etc. and then talked about the types of higher institutions like colleges, universities and autonomous bodies. It was discussed that how the central universities get funds from UGC while the state universities are funded by states.

It was also discussed that there is a huge gap between the management of funds like, sometimes Government imposes some of the policies for example. Any activity to be conducted in NSS under the Swatch Bharat Abhiyan but expect the college to generate funds on their own, thus imposing extra financial burden on the college. In some self finance institutions too there is problem with the salaries of teachers. As these institutes are not directly funded by Government but they generate their funds by charging huge amount of fees from the students but still the teachers are not paid well. She concluded her lecture by giving the group activity to discuss the implications of the emerging financial trends on colleges/ universities including autonomous

bodies. From 11.30 to 1.00 pm group activity was performed followed by lunch from 1-2:00 pm.



Date: 24.12.2019 DAY --5




Date: 26.12.2019 DAY --7


REPORT OF STUDENT VISIT OF AKAL COLLEGE OF EDUCATION, BARU SAHIB 07.2.2020






