**One-Day National Workshop On Developing E – Learning Modules for
Teachers under the Aegis of Rashtriya Uchcharat Shiksha Abhiyan
(RUSA) On Friday 27th January, 2017.**

One day National Workshop on Developing Learning Modules for Teachers was conducted at Dev Samaj College of Education, Sector 36B, Chandigarh, under the aegis of RashtriyaUchcharatShikshaAbhiyan (RUSA) on 27th January 2017. The workshop was held in three sessions: Inaugral session, First Technical Session and a Practical Session. It was presided by dignitaries Prof. SonalChawla, Dr. Sunil Dutt and PuneetModgil. It was attended by teachers from various colleges of Chandigarh and students of the Dev Samaj College of Education Sec 36B, Chandigarh.

Inaugral Session

Prof. Sonal Chawla, the Chief Guest on the occasion discussed the importance of e – learning in the contemporary age, types and various components of e learning in her inaugural address. She started the session by giving definition of e learning by Elliot Massie, “e - learning is use of technology to design, deliver, select, administer, support and extend learning”. She elaborated on four types of categorization: Knowledge database, Online support, live message support systems, forums online bulletin boards, Synchronous and Asynchronous training. She further discussed Four components /Develop Building Block i.e. E learning content, Application,

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She further discussed three basic methods that include Expositive method, Application method and Collaborative method. She also enlightened the participants regarding Content, Good practices and instructional designs.

First Technical Session

Dr. Sunil Dutt of NITTR was the resource person in this session. He stated how globalization has created in number of opportunities in almost all aspect of our life and in particular teaching learning process. He discussed different modes of E-learning that included Distance learning, Moocs, Videoconferencing, Computer based instruction, Interactive T.V. lecture, Assessment and electronic portfolio. He furthered his talk by throwing light on four Factors of E- Learning: Learners, e-learning materials, learning at atmosphere and technology. He also discussed Essential Characteristics, design and development of learning modules, task analysis, analysis and synthesis and advantages and disadvantages of e-learning.

It was followed by query sessions in which several issues on e-learning were taken like online learning, copy paste link, teacher training, roles of MHRD, UGC and RUSA and towards the end the issue of plagiarism was also discussed. The entire session was an enriching experience. Dr. Sunil Dutt elaborated the intricacy and requirement for preparing and designing e learning module. The lecture was very informative and it will definitely help the teacher to develop e-learning module.

Second Session (Practical)

In the second session Hands on experience was given to the participants that included how to launch a website by admin user. How to start a new course by taking approval of the admin, how to interact with students and how students can log in and get access to all the courses. Recordings, classroom lectures and PPTs can be uploaded to benefit the students.

DAY - 1

Seven Days Faculty Development workshop on "Capacity Building of Teachers: Strengthening the Edifice" under the aegis of Rashtriya Uchchatar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA) was inaugurated at Dev Samaj College of Education, Sector 36-B, Chandigarh. Dr. Dilip Kumar, ASPD, RUSA was the Chief Guest and Dr. Karamjeet Singh, Director HRDC, Panjab University, Chandigarh, Sh. Nirmal Singh Dhillon, Secretary Dev Samaj and Dr. Satinder Dhillon, former Principal were also present at the Inaugural ceremony. Dr. Dilip Kumar enlightened the participants regarding the schemes of RUSA and highlighted the importance of research for the progress of any educational institution. Dr. Karamjeet while addressing the gathering spoke on various aspects like Knowledge and research that are needed for enlightened citizens. Sh. Nirmal Singh Dhillon, Secretary, Dev Samaj also motivated all the participants to learn and do better through such workshops. He emphasized on values that are needed to become a 'Man of Character'.

Prof. Karamjit Singh in his inaugural address stated three important aspects that are very important for a teacher. It was well elaborated with an anecdote that a group of thieves wanted to burglar a house but they couldn't because of three reasons: Lamp is burning, moment in the house and a guard outside the house. Mr. Singh concluded that the three reasons are equally important for the teachers as well. Lamp is a knowledge; Teacher should be knowledgeable and knowledge should be updated. Moment means Interaction; Interaction and conversation with friends, peers, colleagues, professionals, guides and experience persons always enhance our knowledge and alert mind; Be conscious, realistic, alert, active and caring.

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College plays an important role in skill development. Dr. Dilip Kumar concluded his speech by emphasizing on three important modules that include Time management, Value and Leadership.

Day 1 (Session 2)

Prof Karamjit Singh from Panjab University conducted the second session. He spoke elaborately on UGC Guidelines for CAS and Direct Appointment. He started by providing some important Amendment Dates. He also made the participants aware about the eligibility level, entry level, promotion for all teaching members at various level of teaching. This session provided a detailed account of how to apply for promotions and everything teachers wanted to know about API. It was indeed a very fruitful day. Prof. Karamjit Singh meticulously answered all doubts of delegates.

Day 7

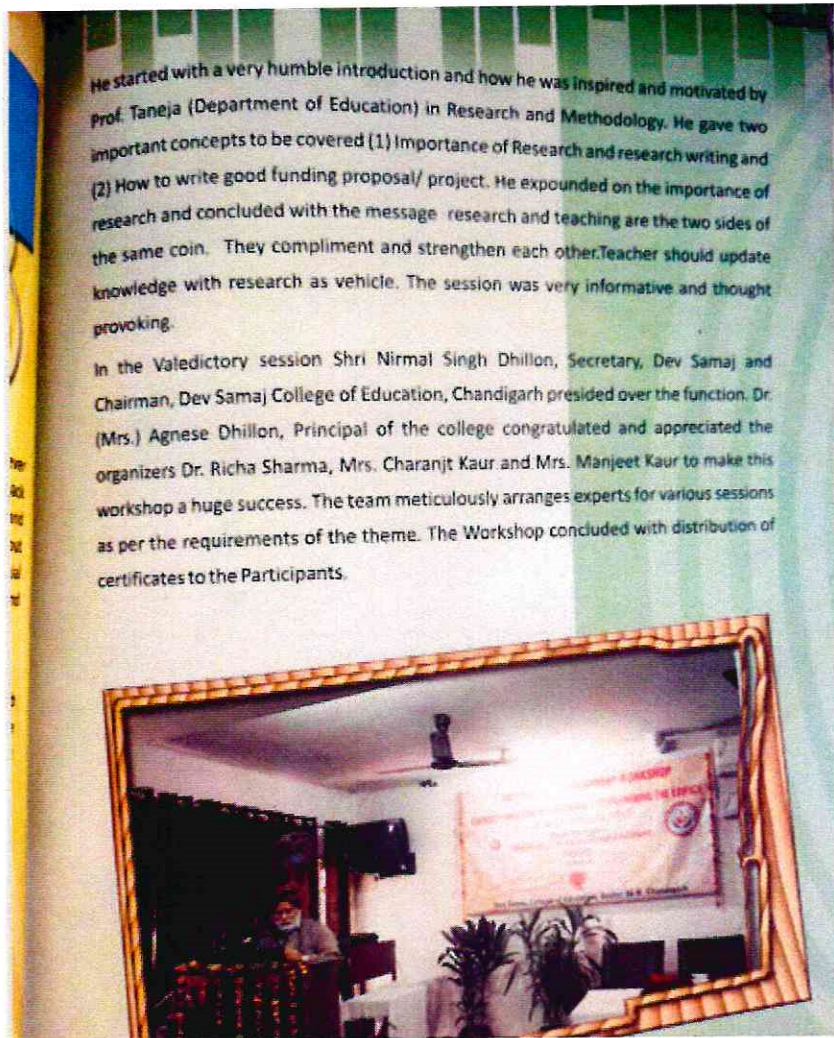

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

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
Global Youth Peace Festival

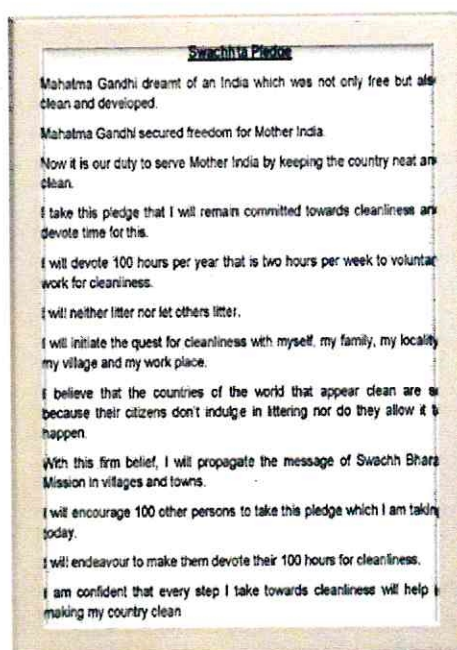
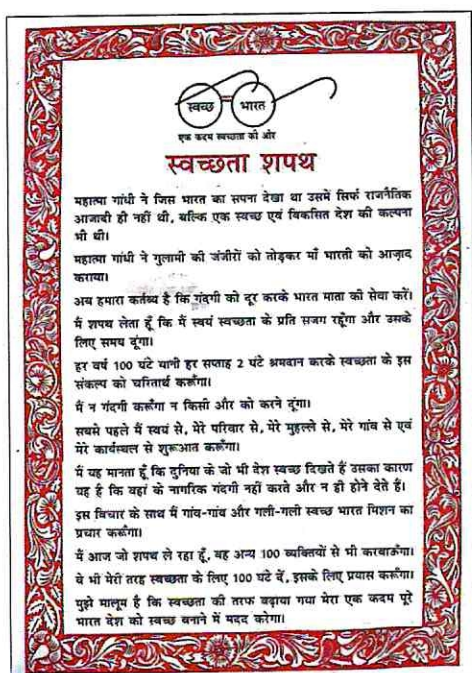
Day One: 1-08-2017 (Tuesday)

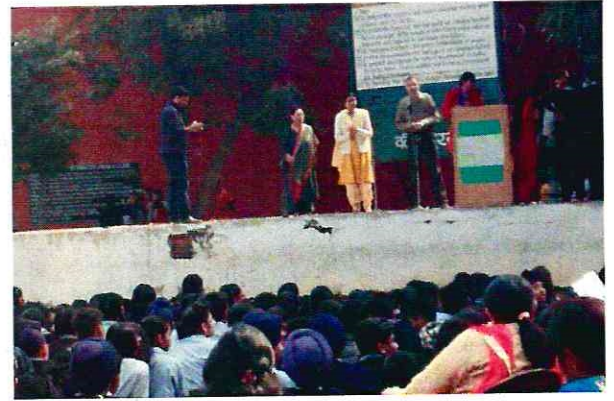

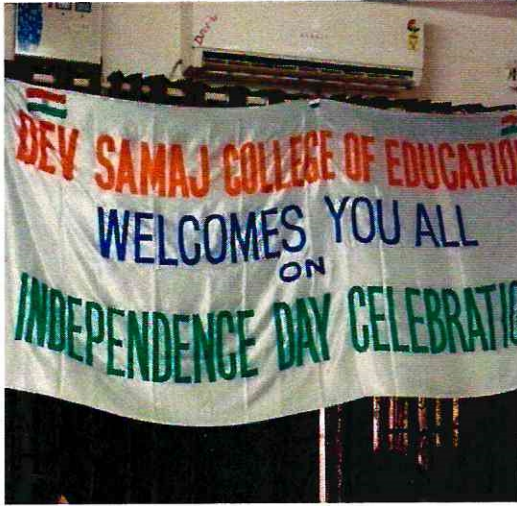

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Independence Day Celebration

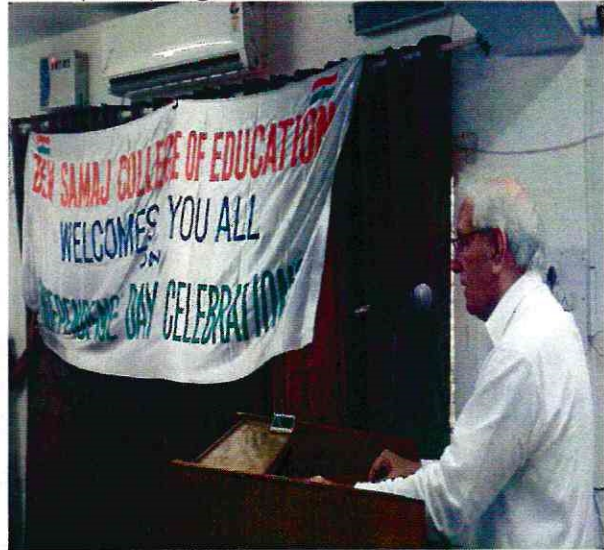

regarding significance and contribution of women in the field of



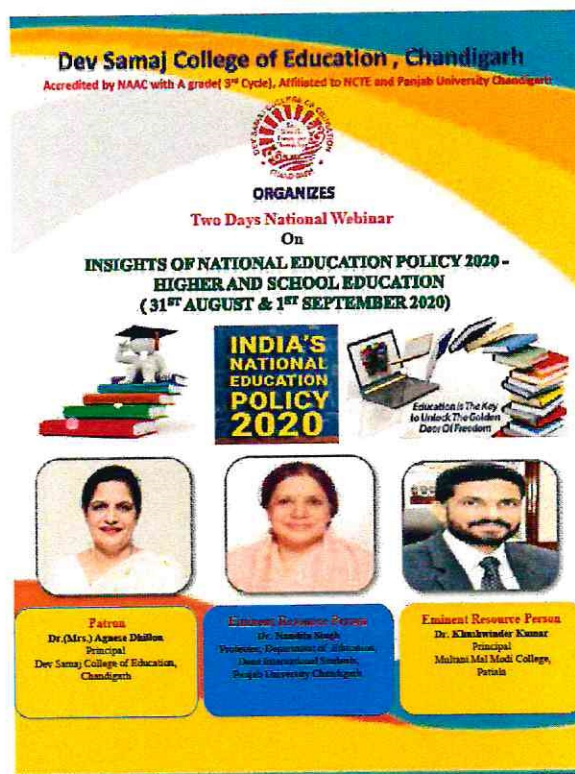

ABOUT THE COURSE

This course is open to students/learners with no prior artmaking experience, it will also provide challenging alternatives for more advanced students—including the opportunity to design, create and execute their own art interventions in their teaching. The syllabus has been designed in lines of UNESCO's Asian Programme of Educational Innovation for Development of Low Cost Educational Materials for both trained educators/facilitators and true beginners in mind.

Most often educators/facilitators have difficulty in delivering adequate learning material for the education outlet. And because of this learning objectives are often not met. As a result there is poor realization of educational goal, and objectives go largely unmet. There are different factors behind this. Those include low budget allocation for production and distribution, poor monitoring mechanism, and weak commitment towards the learning objectives on the part of educators/facilitators. It is a compounded problem. Even if there is intention the limitations are also there.

An educator/facilitator must possess the skills to develop learning material and the talent to express feelings through song, the spoken word or symbolic visual forms. A good educator/facilitator can always use such talent as a resource for devising learning material that suits their students or learning community. The course elaborates on a few tips for using different forms of possible communication format to facilitate learning in the class rooms.

**IETVE (MOOC 'DEVELOPING LOW COST EDUCATIONAL
MATERIAL') (12-10-2020 to 12-11-2020)**

Dev Samaj College initiated MOOC on Educational Innovation for Development of Low Cost Educational Materials. This course was open to students/ learners with no prior art making experience, it also provided challenging alternatives for more advanced students—including the opportunity to design, create and execute their own art interventions in their teaching, The syllabus had been designed in lines of UNESCO's Asian Programme of Educational Innovation for Development of Low Cost Educational Materials for both trained educators/ facilitators and true beginners in mind.


Most often educators/facilitators have difficulty in delivering adequate learning material for the education outlet. And because of this learning objectives are often not met. As a result there is poor realization of educational goal, and objectives go largely unmet. There are different factors behind this. These include low budget allocation for production and distribution, poor monitoring mechanism, and weak commitment towards the learning objectives on the part of educators/facilitators. It is a compounded problem. Even if there is intention the limitations are also there. With this aim course was conceived by Dr. Richa Sharma, Associate Professor, Dev Samaj College of Education.

MOOC ON “EFFECTIVE PROBLING SOLVING AND MATHEMATICAL SKILLS” (27-10-2020 TO 26-11-2020)

Dr. Kiranjit Kaur Associate Professor in Education (Teaching of mathematics), developed a MOOC ON “EFFECTIVE PROBLING SOLVING AND MATHEMATICAL SKILLS” (27-10-2020 to 26-11-2020)

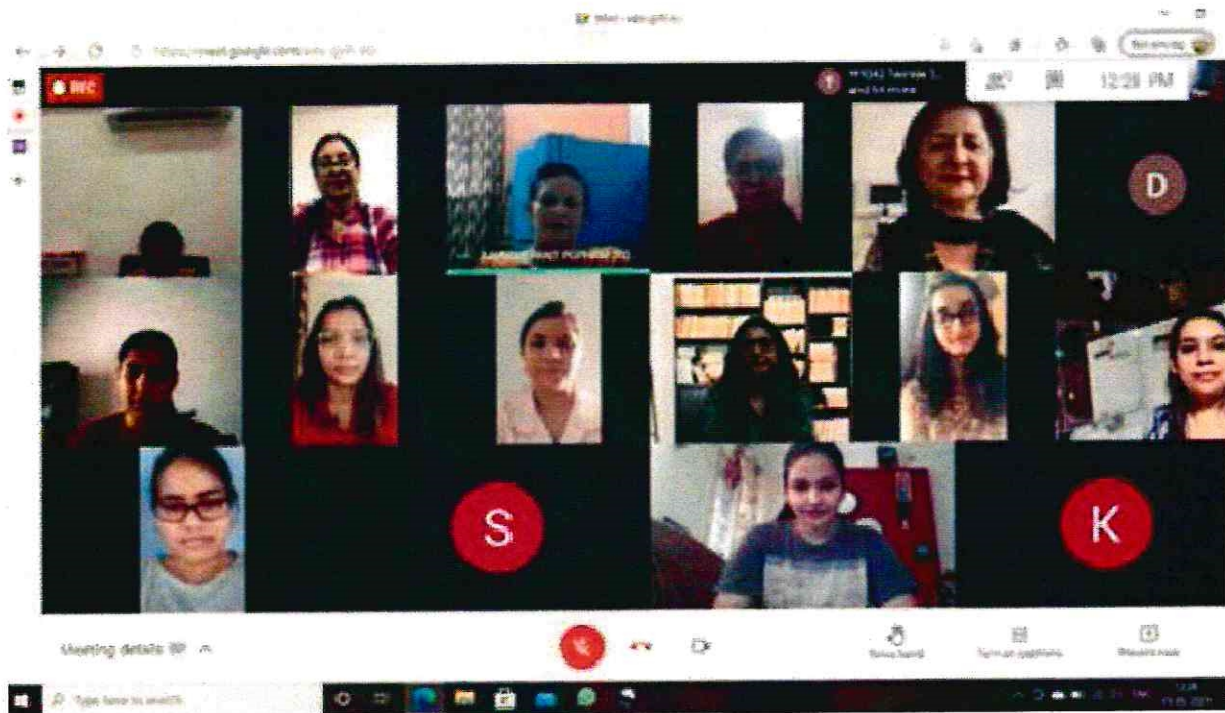
WEBINAR SERIES 2 ON IMPLEMENTING SIGN LANGUAGE IN THE CLASSROOM (19-05-2021)

This will help them speak "without" speaking, which might prove immensely beneficial for children who aren't very comfortable verbalising what they are going through. 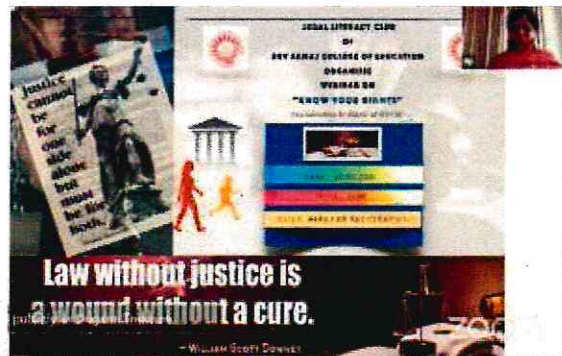

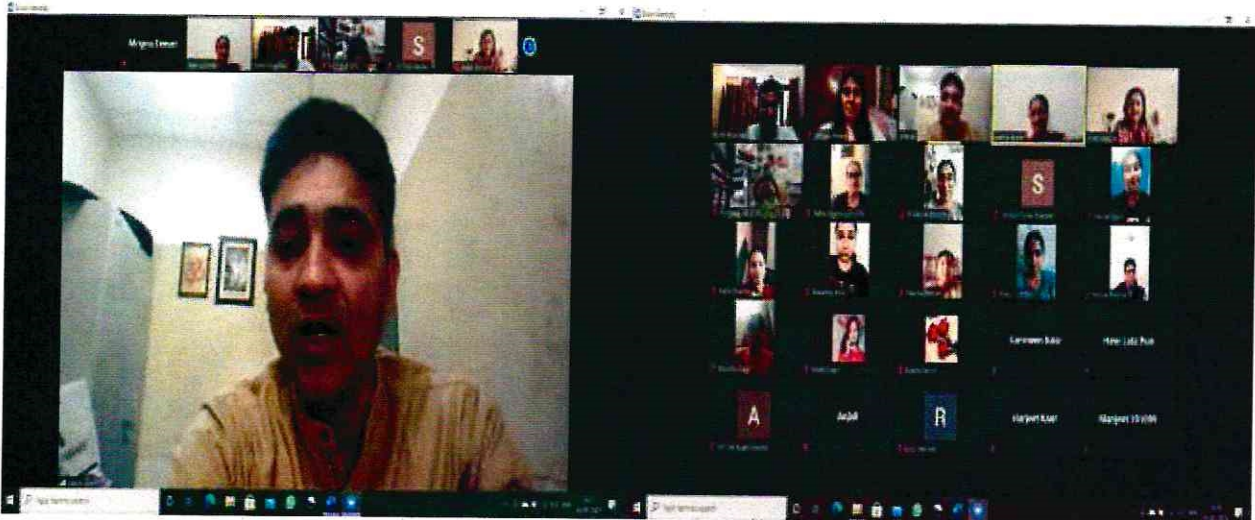
